Cost Saving Programs & Assistance for Older Adults

- Medicare Savings Program: This program helps those on Medicare get the premium they pay for their Medicare Part B back in their Social Security check.
 - To qualify you must be on Medicare and be under the gross income levels: Individuals: \$2,280 Couples: \$3,077
 - There are also two programs to assist with the cost of prescription medications- Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage (EPIC) and the Low Income Subsidy (LIS). You can call the numbers below to see if you qualify.

- ❖ The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is a nutrition assistance program. SNAP provides benefits to eligible low-income individuals and families via an Electronic Benefits Transfer card. This card can be used like a debit card to purchase eligible food in authorized retail food stores.
 - If you are over 60, to qualify your income must be under the gross income levels: 1 person household: \$2,265 2 person household: \$3,052

- ❖ Food Pantries: Local Food Pantries can provide food items.

- ❖ Food Sense Food Co-op Program: Food Sense is a great way for individuals to save money and purchase quality foods for less. Each package of food or unit is filled with high quality meats, vegetables, fruits, and grocery items. There are no restrictions-If you eat you qualify. - Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)- The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps low-income people pay the cost of heating their homes.
