Ruth was born into the foster system saying she was "underestimated but never quit proving people wrong," publishing the story of her life in the book "Ruthie Deeply." It is a story of strength and perseverance. Ruth has spent her whole life helping others and giving back. She makes the world brighter for those who need a ray of sunshine.

Volney "Spike" Seeley is known for his friendly demeanor and constant smile. He is not only loved by his fellow volunteers but also deeply appreciated by the clients he serves. His ability to bring people together, foster a sense of community, and offer encouragement during difficult times has made a lasting difference. 
